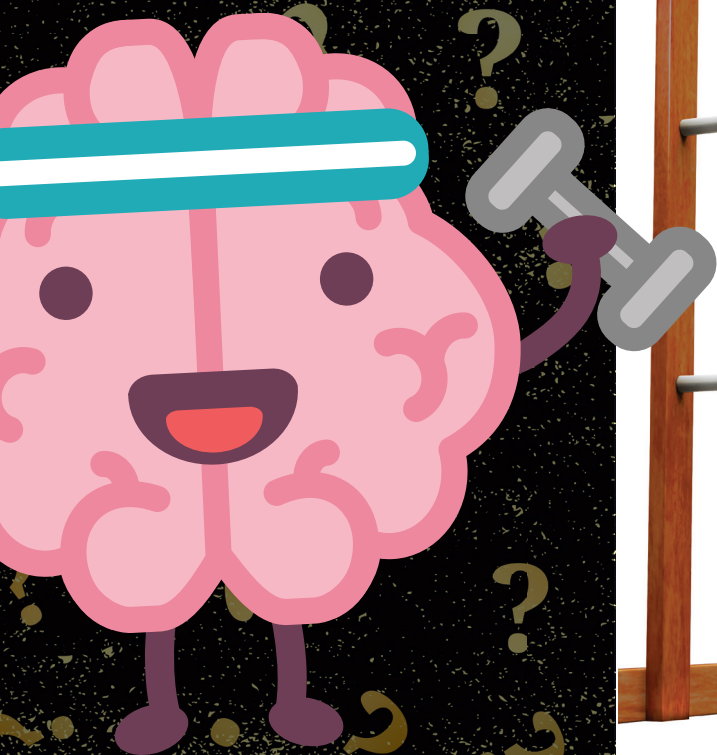

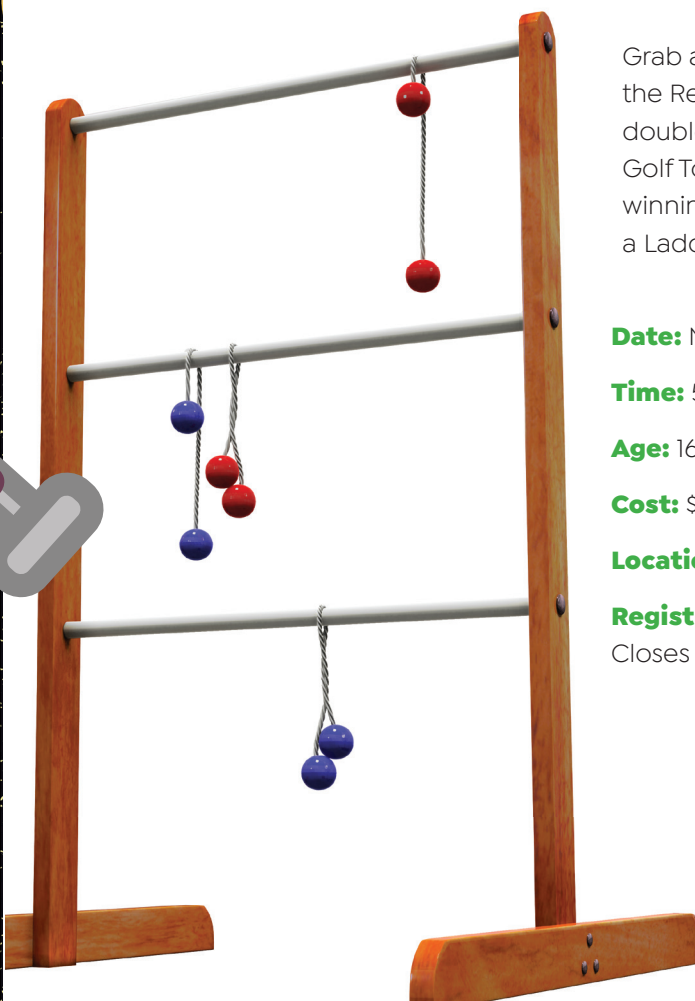

- Comfort with water and instructor
- Able to fully submerge face in the water
- Front and back floats with support
- Jump in and find the wall
- Independently exit the water

Preschool Level 2

- Superman glide on belly – assisted
- Bobs – five using wall for support
- Jump into water – assisted
- Back float – assisted
- Introduction to treading water

Preschool Level 3

- Superman glide on belly – unassisted
- Bobs – 10 using wall for support
- Jump into water – unassisted
- Roll from belly to back to take a breath – unassisted
- Tread water – learning hands and legs

Levels for 6 years old and up

Beginners

Guardian 16 or older must be in water with child

Advanced Beginner

- Step from the side into chest deep water completely submerging, push off the bottom, tread water least 15 seconds.
- Swim on their front or back for 5 body lengths
- Back float for 1 minute

Novice

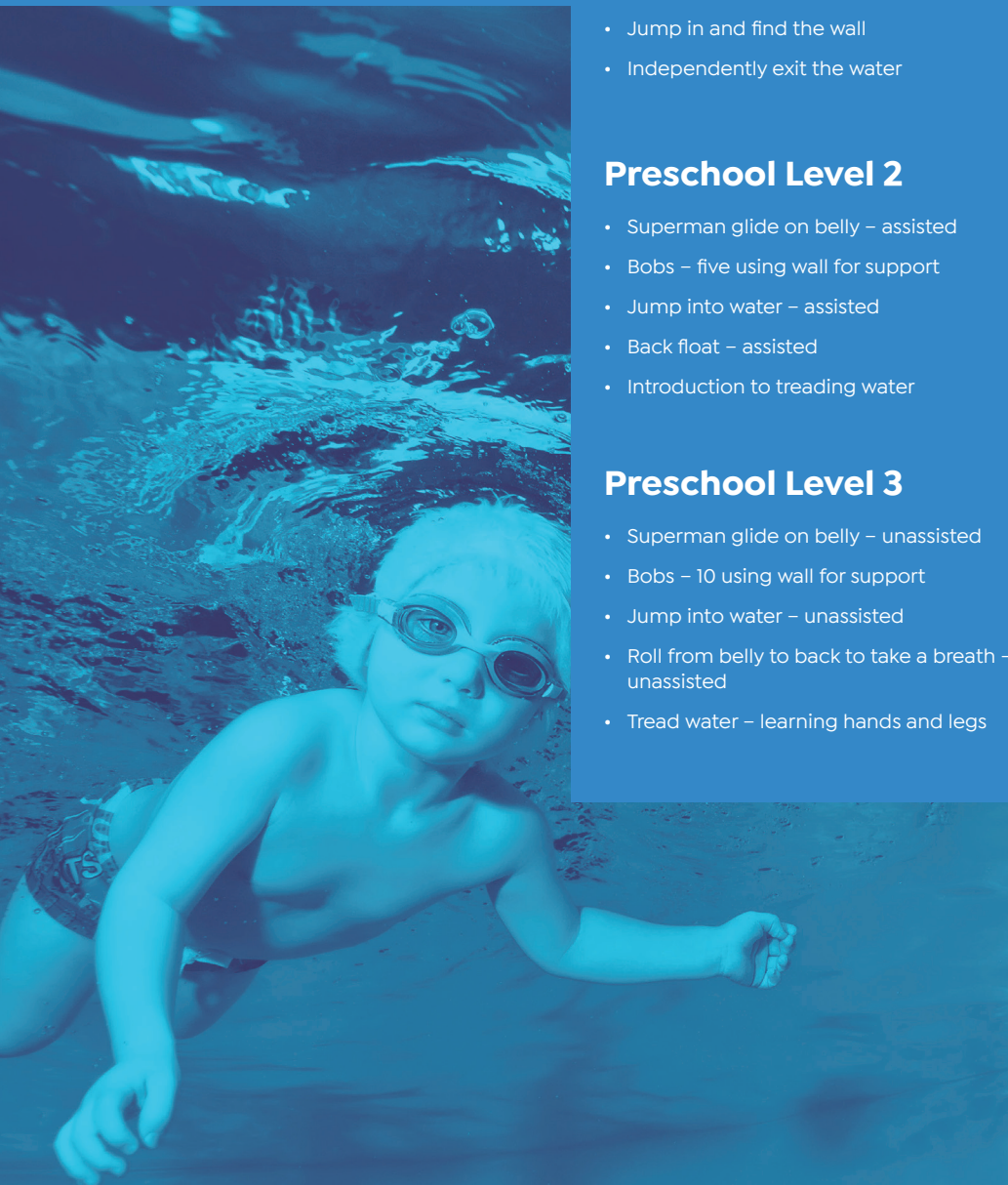
(For those preparing for swim team)

- Jump into deep water from the side/ recover to surface floating on back for 1 minute.
- Swim front crawl 25 meters
- Swim backstroke for 15 yards
- Tread water for 1 minute.

Intermediate

(Previously White Group swim team)

- Jump into deep water, immediately swim front crawl for 25 yards
- Swim backstroke for 25 yards
- Swim breaststroke 15 yards
- Swim butterfly 15 yards.

Want stroke development? Ready to compete at USA meets? We have the place for you on the Morenci Swim Team!

*Must pass Advanced Swim Lessons or be able to swim a continuous 200 freestyle.

Group Descriptions:

Red Group

11 to 18 year old swimmers with a desire to train and compete at a higher level and have undergone coach's evaluation.

Grey Group

10-18 year old swimmers who are returning summer swimmers, year-round athletes, or have undergone coach's evaluation.

White Group

This group has been merged with swim lessons to provide our athletes with a more hands on experience as they learn the basic techniques of stroke development. Please see the swim lesson descriptions to register your child for the appropriate level (i.e. Beginners, Advanced Beginners, Novice, Intermediate, and Advanced.)

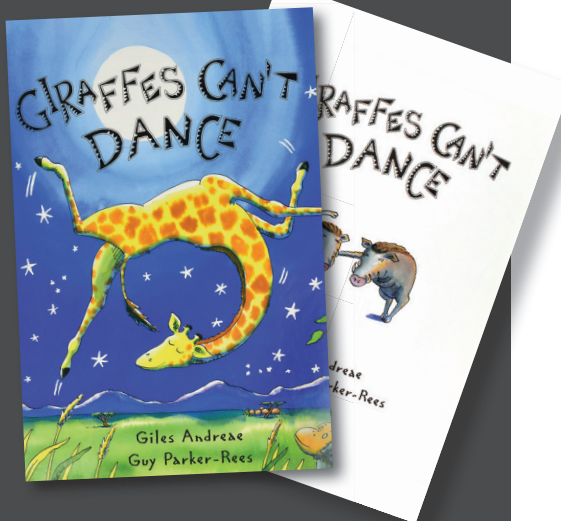

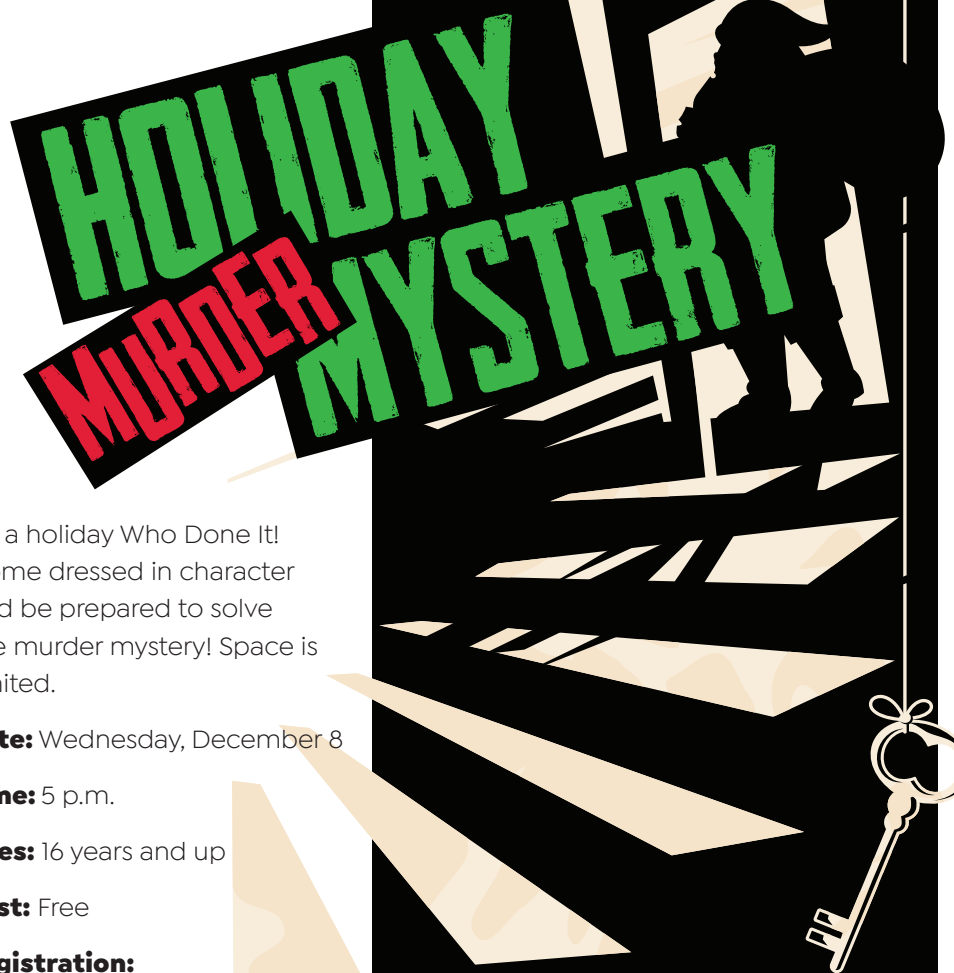

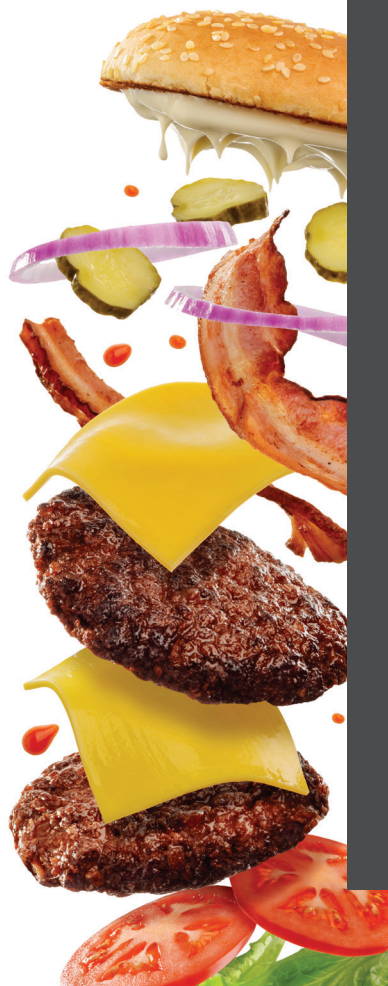
